Participants in this Contest are the winners, or in the case where the winner is unable to compete in the Multiple District contest, the runner-up of the competition held at the District Conference. The District Governor shall submit the name of the District winner and runner up to the MD19 Contests and Awards Chairperson and the MD19 Office within 30 days of his/her District Spring Conference.

The maximum length of the **TALL TALE** shall be three (3) minutes. A ten (10) point penalty will be assessed for each minute or portion thereof over three (3) minutes.

### **JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:**

40%	Originality
40%	Delivery
10%	Humor
10%	Crowd Response

NOTE: A Tall Tale is not to be just a joke. A Tall Tale should be a tale of an exaggerated life experience, true or imagined.

The Tall Tale should not contain material that would tend to offend any ethnic or minority group and bad language should be avoided.
