Participants in this Contest are the winners, or in the case where the winner is unable to compete in the Multiple District contest, the runner-up of the competition held at the District Conference. **The District Governor shall submit the name of the District winner and runner up to the MD19 Contests and Awards Chairperson and the MD19 Office within 30 days of his/her District Spring Conference.**

The maximum length of the **HUMOROUS STORY** shall be Four (3) minutes. A ten (10) point penalty will be assessed for each minute or portion thereof over three (3) minutes.

JUDGING WILL BE BASED ON:

	10 points	Visual contact with audience
	15 points	Speech (tone, volume and speed)
	10 points	Facial expression
	25 points	Humor (points will be deducted for offensive content)
	25 points	Crowd Response

Definition of offensive language: material that would tend to offend any ethnic or minority group and bad language / swear words MUST not be used.

The Contests & Awards Committee shall provide three (3) judges.
